

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. A participant's parents must provide income and employer information on all scholarship requests. The reason for the scholarship may be one of the following: single parent family with limited income, medical hardship with limited income, income hardship, multiple youth from the same family household attending and this presents a financial hardship to attend camp. If the participant is registered with a Scout or Explorer unit, the unit should help provide funding or the unit sponsor can help provide funding.
2. Where possible, the youth participant should have completed some type of fundraising event to help raise money to pay for participation.
3. The participant must provide one of the following to support his need for a scholarship:
 - a. A signed statement from his/her school principal, or authorized school representative, stating that he/she qualifies for reduced lunches or activity fee waiver, requested by the parent or guardian.
 - b. Minister or employer, sign a statement that the participant's parents have a financial or medical hardship that would prevent them from being able to pay for STEM X, requested by the parent or guardian.
4. **Participants should already have registered for STEM X online and paid their \$200 deposit before submitting the scholarship application. Questions or concerns about this can be directed to colin.lemon@scouting.org.**
5. **Scholarships approved are not transferable to another participant attending STEM X.**
6. Forms not properly completed will be returned to the parent and will not be considered by the scholarship committee until completed properly.
7. All scholarship requests must be properly completed and submitted to the ONSC office no later than **March 15, 2017**.
8. All requests will be considered by a scholarship committee of not less than five members of the STEM Committee appointed by the chair of the STEM Committee.
9. **The Old North State Council office should be notified immediately prior to the participant attending STEM X if he/she is not able to attend so funds can be used for other needed scholarships.**
10. A scholarship is limited to one third of the camp fee at that camp.
